Essential workshop prep

- <u>Visit Save Make Reinvent resources</u> to download all the resources you will need, including printing out the iOi My Invention Idea resource for the workshop
- Ask pupils to collect up to 3 pieces of clean waste using the checklist. You could even ask ahead in the parents/ carers' newsletter to get their whole families involved. Why not keep a clear bin liner ready to collect them all?
- Children can work in groups of 3 or 4 so print off a My Invention Idea resource for each group and prepare the materials listed in our checklist
- Test that you will be able to access the workshop on the day. Click the <u>test link</u> to check firewall access and that your audio and video works

Suggestion: extend the learning

- Take 10 minutes as a class to discuss what happens to the items you put in general, garden or recycling bins. Think what happens to them when they end up in a landfill
- In groups, discuss the pieces of junk waste that they brought in and whether they can be recycled, reused, repurposed or whether they will end up in a landfill
- Using the My Idea Invention resource, ask each pupil to think of an idea that can help Save Make Reinvent in our world or in their school or community
