Essential workshop prep

- Visit [Save Make Reinvent resources](#) to download all the resources you will need, including printing out the iOi Colour Palette resource for the workshop
- Ask pupils to bring in food scraps and other items from nature. Why not ask ahead in the parents/ carers' newsletter to get their whole families involved too?
- Children can work individually so print off the Colour Palette resource and prepare enough of the materials listed in our checklist

Suggestion: extend the learning

- Take 10 minutes as a class to brainstorm 20 different ways that you can make colour from food waste or things in nature
- KS2: As a class, research how colour is made in the world for our products, such as paints and clothes

- Why not go foraging as a class and find suitable materials or talk with the school kitchen staff about their food waste?
