Laughing Automata Machines Quick Guide



What is the Laughing Automata Machines workshop?

iOi STEAM Live is a programme run by the educational charity, the Institute of Imagination (iOi), which helps children build future critical skills as well as developing their literacies in digital, design and engineering concepts, and scientific enquiry through STEAM.

In this Laughing Automata Machines workshop by the iOi, your class will invent, design and build wire crank mechanisms to explore the neuroscience of laughter, activating our brain's 'feel-good' transmitters and releasing our 'feel good' hormones to bring laughter and joy.

Preparation for Broadcast

- Children in KS1 will be working on groups of 4, KS2: in pairs
- · Gather all the craft materials you will need
- Pre-cut the wire roll into 25 cm pieces for every group/pair
- For K\$1, pierce two holes in each cup with the wooden skewer on opposite sides about half way up the cup so the wire can go straight through it
- Access the Streamyard link to the live broadcast (this was emailed to the teacher who signed your class up to the programme) and ensure that your audio and visual are working. If you want to take part in our Show and Tell session at the end, test that your camera works.
